Arrival and presentation: 16th September 2023 from 08:00 to 08:30

Each competitor will present his/her ID, weapon TP and weapon, in case of absence of documents he/she will not be admitted to the competition.

The competitor shall confirm by signature that he/she understands the rules of the competition (familiarization with the rules of the competition).

Opening of the competition: 16th September 2023 at 08:30 with the entry of the competitors

Shooting part: 16th Sep 2023 from 09:00 - 22:00 17th Sep 2023 from 09:00 - 12:00

Closing of the shooting part of the competition: 17 th Sep 2023 by 12:00

Announcement of results: 17 th Sep 2023 at 13:00

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- evaluation under PRS rules;
- > shooting competition for individuals (up to 1000 m);
- each competitor is equipped with his/her own rifle and ammunition;
- maximum number of competitors 40;
- starting numbers will be assigned to the competitors by the organizer;
- ➤ the competition entry and start number will be sent in a confirmation email to the address given by the entrants;
- the rifles used by the competitors must be of a calibre no larger than 7.82 mm (0.308''), at muzzle velocities no greater than 980 m/s⁻¹ (3,200 ft/s⁻¹);
- semi-automatic weapons will be evaluated in a special category;
- the number of rounds in the magazine must not exceed the quantity specified per shooting stage;
- competition will be conducted in any weather conditions that will allow a target situation to be set up;
- > the competitor will be briefed on the exact rules and target situation prior to the start of each event;
- > medical security for the competitors will be provided by the organizer;
- ripod, rangefinder, third leg, bags, etc. are **not prohibited**; the referee will tell the competitors before each discipline what can be used for that discipline;
- observation and correction by another person are prohibited;
- the use of armour piercing ammunition is strictly prohibited;
- prohibition of any manipulation or touching of targets;
- all participants are required to always follow the instructions of the judges during the competition. Any violation of safe weapon handling = DISQUALIFICATION (DQ).

SHOOTING EQUIPMENT:

- rifle with optical device and accessories;
- ammunition 200 pcs rifle, calibre max. .308Win., 25 pcs 9 mm Luger, 25 pcs .223Rem.
- ear protection;
- eye protection recommended;
- shooting equipment and supplies.



RULES AND GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- referees are responsible for the construction of the target situation in each discipline;
- competitors are obliged to follow the instructions of the referees;
- competitors are obliged to ensure safe handling of the weapon at all times and under all circumstances and observe safety precautions at all times during the shooting competition;
- ➤ all targets to be shot at during the item will be familiarized by the referees prior to the start of the shooting. It will be explained (briefing) how the stage will be scored, the scoring of the shot and the rules of the stage (procedure);
- if unclear, the referee will be contacted and questions will be asked;
- > evaluation of shooting disciplines according to PRS standards;
- in case of a disputed situation, the final opinion is the responsibility of the referees.

DISCIPLINES AND EVALUATION OF THE COMPETITION:

- competition seeks to strike a balance between speed and accuracy in hitting targets that may have known or unknown distances. Shooting distances can vary from 25 to 1000 meter;
- > evaluation in the category individuals "bolt-action" 1st 3rd place;
- evaluation in the category individuals "semi-auto" 1st 3rd place;
- "The Best of 1000";
- the referees under the direction of the Chief Referee are responsible for the evaluation and processing of the competition results.

SECURITY MEASURES:

- keep the muzzle always pointed in a safe direction regardless of the condition of the weapon. Do not point any weapon at anything other than the designated targets;
- keep your finger off the trigger and off the bow until you are ready to shoot;
- weapons out of position will be in the unload condition;
- each competitor must obey the orders of the judges, follow safety precautions;
- competitors are prohibited from interfering with the judges;
- any movement with a weapon outside the tented areas to perform the competition disciplines is only possible without a cartridge in the chamber and with the magazines removed – weapon unloaded;
- each judge has the possibility to check the condition of the weapons at any time;



- handling of the weapon (including filling magazines with ammunition) may only be done by the shooter in designated areas on the command of the judges;
- if necessary, manipulate the weapon outside these areas after consultation with the referee, who will determine the safe direction and area where the action can be performed.

COMPETITORS:

- shooter is solely responsible for fully understanding the rules of the competition before starting, in case of confusion or misunderstanding of a shooting stage, he/she may approach the referee to clarify the situation;
- shooters are fully responsible for their equipment, including firearms and ammunition.
 A firearm deemed unsafe may be grounds for exclusion.

REFEREES:

- referee is marked with a **yellow** reflective vest;
- referees have the duty to prevent any situation that will be contrary to the rules of the competition and the safety rules of shooting;
- referees have the duty to brief the shooter in detail about each shooting situation before it starts - safe area for barrel pointing, method of execution (procedures), targets and special features;
- ➤ at the conclusion of each shooting situation, the referee is required to inspect the condition of the weapons and magazines;
- the scoring system will be communicated to the competitor by the judges prior to each event;
- ➤ the judges are not allowed to assist the competitors in any way or give advice to the competitors for handling the situations;
- > judges have the right to disqualify a competitor if safety and rules of each discipline are violated.



COMMANDS USED IN COMPETITION

ČESKY	ENGLISH	ACTIVITIES OF COMPETITORS
Nabij a připrav se.	Load and make ready.	At the preparation line, they bring the weapon to the state prescribed for the situation (loaded or ready) and take the required starting position.
Střelec připraven?	Shooter ready?	At the preparation line, they bring the weapon to the state prescribed for the situation (loaded or ready) and take the required starting position. The shooter must verbally signal "Yes".
Příprav se.	Standby.	This command is followed by a start signal (timer) within 3-4 seconds.
Stop!	Stop!	This command may be given by the referee at any time during the shooting situation (e.g. when the SR is disturbed). The competitor is obliged to stop shooting immediately and wait for further instructions from the referee.
Pokud jsi skončil, vybij zbraň a ukaž prázdnou.	If you are finished, unload and show clear.	At the end of the shooting situation, the competitor shall submit the weapon to the referee for inspection. The muzzle of the weapon must be pointed into a safe area, the magazine must be removed, the slide in the rear position and the chamber empty.

The competition is designed to test the shooter's ability to accurately eliminate a target within the time limit, effectively correct climatic and other factors affecting shooting accuracy, and to operationally evaluate and resolve situations as they arise.

A high level of professionalism and sportsmanship is expected. All participants, including range officials, shooters, and spectators, will be always treated with the utmost respect.

A strict prohibition of alcoholic beverages and the use of psychotropic and narcotic substances applies throughout the competition!!!

Failure to comply with the established rules of the competition in any way will not be tolerated and the competitor will receive immediate disqualification.



ACCOMMODATION:

- ➤ after the end of the night part of the competition is allowed to sleep in the reserved area of the shooting range, your own mattress and sleeping bag;
- all participants of the shooting competition are obliged to follow the instructions of the organizer;
- in case of bad weather it is possible to have accommodation outside the shooting range, see ACCOMMODATION IN THE AREA, everyone has to book individually.
